



Bryan is a Wildlife Biologist for the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. He has been stationed in Appleton for the last 3 years. He has spent the previous 12 years working in Oshkosh, Spring Green and Madison. He is responsible for managing 16,000 acres of DNR owned land in Outagamie and Northern Winnebago County. He holds a Bachelor's degree in Wildlife Management and Biology from the University of Wisconsin – Stevens Point.

Northeast Wisconsin Alliance, Inc. (NEW Alliance) partnered with the DNR to recruit and organize volunteers to monitor eagle presence or absence during winter along the Fox River from Lake Winnebago in Neenah to Wrightstown. This partnership has been collecting data since January 2009. Data collected on eagles presence is used to determine the overall health of the ecosystem through identifying critical wintering, nesting, roosting, and feeding sites on 20 + miles of river. This presentation will discuss the project and data collected during the first 8 years of monitoring.
